Stay at home if unwell. We really enjoy seeing you in church each week however, please stay at home if you are unwell.

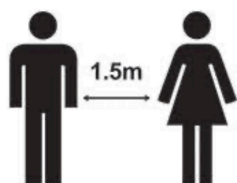


Carry a mask at all times, and wear it in church.
