Current Covid-Safe use of the Church and Hall

A staged process is currently underway towards holding worship services & other activities at St George's with increased numbers of participants in both the church and the hall.

Until further notice the maximum number of participants for activities in the church will be limited to no more than 80 and in the hall to 38.

Groups hiring our hall have commenced meeting, under strict Covid-Safe protocols, including the submission of a Covid-safe plan, meticulous attention to cleaning, handwashing, mask wearing when required, and distancing during activities. Based on the density quotient of the hall and depending on the nature of the activity, the maximum number of participants in these activities is 38 or 19, plus the person conducting the activity. The number of participants in activities in the hall would seem unlikely to be increased in the near future.

We will continue to provide various devotional activities and materials on the website, and some in hard copy form, which can be carried out at home.

You are welcome to use our garden for appropriate, permitted activities – please keep numbers in the garden within the physical distancing recommendations.
