The Friends of Music Concert at St Georges Anglican Church, Baroda Street, 41 Baroda Street Travancore on Sunday 6 July 2025 was of the usual exceptionally high standard.

The concerts, performed within the historic and acoustically superb Church are always an opportunity to experience an intimate, classical and quality music performance. They support emerging musicians, provide an opportunity to meet other music loving locals and are followed by much appreciated refreshments.

The FOMS series was first held at St Georges in 2016 and is a much-loved feature of the parish's life. Concerts are held monthly and feature a variety of performers and instruments in chamber combinations.

This concert featured Clarinettist Jeffrey Rosenfeld, soprano Lily Flynn and Coady Green and presented Franz Schubert's much loved "Shepherd on the Rock", alongside lesser-known works.

Other works performed included German composer Conrad Kreutzer's "Das Muhlrads" (In Yonder Valley), Johann Kalliwoda's Heimathlied (Homesong) and Gerald Finzi's "Five Bagatelles".

A very appreciative audience thoroughly enjoyed this Concert. If you love classical music performed in a chamber orchestra format, these concerts are for you.

Admission is \$25.00 for adults, with concessions also available.
